


Pasaules Dabas Fonds is associated partner of World Wide Fund for Nature (WWF) in Latvia.






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Figure 1: The global Living

1.27°C right now




1.5°C threshold

# Context (educational)







Only 19% of students in Latvia have a full understanding of citizenship, although the importance of civic education in the existence of democracy has been emphasized in numerous studies.

At the same time, 57% of young people in Latvia estimate that they could get involved in civic activities, but only 24% have done so.



«Fully align strategies and plans in education and training with environmental sustainability, including those related to curricula and assessment, pedagogies and educator professional development.»

The public survey conducted by the Pasaules Dabas Fonds "Interests of young people and their views on the priorities of Latvian decision-makers over the next 10 years" reveals that the majority (91%) of young people aged 16-25 thinks it is very important for Latvia to contribute to global environmental and nature crisis mitigation.






This is the first publicly available study of its kind on the interests of 16-25 year olds in Latvia, their views on current environmental issues and priorities that should guide decisionmakers in Latvia over the next 10 years in the environmental sector, sustainable development and civic participation.





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
On average, only 32% of young people in Latvia believe that educational institutions give them a good and excellent understanding of the impact of goods and services on the environment, climate change mitigation, species and habitat conservation, civic participation, democracy and other issues.





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## Outcome of the research



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Pasaules Dabas Fonds called all stakeholders to work together to integrate environmental issues effectively into education.

In September 2021, an *Informal working* group on environmental education was established, which unites >7 nongovernmental organizations to jointly participate in environmental education advocacy activities, as well as offers teachers and students environmental education opportunities.




